Agent Surveillance:

Observe gaming and non-gaming activity by monitoring electronic surveillance equipment to ensure compliance with applicable laws, procedures, regulations and rules and protect company assets from illegal or questionable activities. (Must be 21 or over)

Compliance Specialist:

Responsible for reading, comprehending, and interpreting gaming regulations, requirements, and controls to assist the property in ensuring that procedures and processes are in compliance.

Director of Finance:

Serves as strategic business partner for General Manager and department heads. Responsible for interpreting financial results and collaborating with property leadership to improve financial performance. Leadership responsibility to provide guidance to property leadership on financial implications of operational decisions. Responsible for direct oversight of Cage and property Finance and indirect oversight of Count Team and Receiving/Warehousing.

Casino Host

Interact with and provide exceptional service to established guests to enhance the guest's experience. Actively recruit new players through verbal communication on the gaming floor. Build and enhance existing customer relationships via telephone and written correspondence. Assist in promotional events, issue comps based on established guidelines.

Revenue Audit Clerk:

Review, summarize, and audit supporting revenue information relating to operating departments. Verify all revenue paperwork from various revenue centers. Book revenue and expenses to the general ledger.

Slot Shift Supervisor:

Responsible for the supervision of Slot personnel during an assigned shift. Ensure the security and accountability of slot funds. Ensure all Company policies and procedures and Indiana gaming regulations are consistently followed.
